

### Director's Note

We are so grateful to be collaborating with the wonderful artists of Iola Community Theatre! As soon as this partnership became a possibility, I knew we had to do Harvey, because this is the kind of play that brings people together. People of all ages, from all walks of life can find joy in it's magic! Many of you may remember Jimmy Stewart in his iconic role as Elwood P. Dowd in the movie version that came out in 1950, but this play was first released in 1944, towards the end of World War II. Harvey was written as a way to help America cope with the devastation of a war filled with horrors and loss. In the world of Harvey, old Irish folktales come to life and our sweet and generous protagonist embraces all things kind and gentle. Although Harvey is about a man who seems delusional to his family and friends, the play unabashedly reinforces optimism and faith in a cynical world--a message that was much needed in the mid-1940s. Because Mary Chase wrote her Pulitzer Prize winning play in response to a specific time and culture, some critics say that Harvey is now old-fashioned. I couldn't disagree more. Just as Harvey enchanted audiences hungry for humor and hope in the face of war, we as a society need both those things now more than ever. Our world feels more divided and isolated every day. So we asked ourselves: What if Elwood isn't the one who's got it all wrong ... What if we are? In our version of the play, we wanted to embrace the childlike wonder, and make it seem as if a children's storybook had come to life! When we're children, the whole world is fresh and exciting and anything is possible! Many of us, for one reason or another, lose that feeling somewhere along the way. Elwood P. Dowd hasn't lost it, though. Not literally or figuratively. Elwood might just be the sanest one of all. We ask you to let yourself tap into the joy of childhood as you watch the play. We ask you, even just for the next few hours, to believe in magic!
