

K.U. Fine Arts Grant

When Kansas University received a grant from the Higher Education Act in 1965, the funds were meant to be used to assist the Allen County Arts Council in its program activities for county residents. A joint project of the University of Kansas Extension and the Council has been initiated, with the idea of the grant providing some additional financial assistance to the council to gain personnel, and supplies, in order to do more than it could have by itself, without this aid. The program is meant to help the county help itself to develop its resources of talent in music, drama and art.

The Iola Community Theatre has come a long way in a short time and the Council would like to produce similar results in art and music. Mrs. Simmons serves as Field Representative in Iola, supervising the program at the local level. Tom Rea is the Project Director from Kansas University. Kay McNeive is co-ordinator between Mr. Rea at K.U. and Mrs. Simmons and the Council.

A Creative Dramatics Program is being launched the second week in January to train adults in the community to consequently give children the rewards that can be reaped from such training, to bring fun and an appreciation of the art of the theatre.

Plans for projects in vocal and instrumental music and art for community residents are at present in preparatory stages, and it is hoped there will soon be something concrete in these areas also, to offer those who live in Allen County. Contributions to the Allen County Arts Council Theatre are used to maintain the momentum which has been established in the past two years and to accelerate our program in the coming year.

Donations to the Theatre fall into three categories: Sponsors, 10 or more memberships; Donors, 5 or more; and Patrons, 1 or more.
